



E-Poster FAQs

Q. What are the screen dimensions?

A. The actual, useable screen size is 40.97x23.04. Presentation slides should be set to these dimensions for best results, which is a 16:9 ratio 1080p resolution (1920x1080 pixels).

Q. Are portrait or landscape presentations accepted?

A. For WUSS, landscape mode will be used.

Q. What font type and size should I use?

A. Recommended fonts are Calibri, Arial or Times New Roman with 28 pt. or larger font size.

Q. What is the average number of pages in an e-poster?

A. On average, presenters will normally have **no more than three to five** pages of content in their e- posters, including hyperlinked (enlarged) images, rotating graphics or embedded videos.

Q. What presentation software do I use to create an e-poster?

A. Use PowerPoint.

Q. How large can my e-poster file be?

A. Limit your file size to 100MB or less.

Q. How do I advance slides?

A. Presentations can be set up to advance slides by mouse click. A mouse is provided with each e-poster so that you can advance your presentation at your own discretion. You can also set up your e-poster to automatically advance slides.

Q. What devices can I bring my e-poster on?

A. Your final e-poster must be uploaded to the Presenter Resource Center by **July 19, 2020**. WUSS staff will be loading all e-poster presentations onto the e-poster system before the conference. Recommended time between slides is 60- 90 seconds.

Q. Can I edit my e-poster on-site?

A. This is strongly discouraged as updates will need to be made to each display, but you may discuss with the ePoster Section Chair.



Q. What are the e-poster stand dimensions?

A. Landscape Mode

Height – 83" (~7feet)

Width – 43" (3.6feet)

Depth – 38 1/3" (3.2feet)

Q. What's included with an e-poster?

A. Each e-poster consists of a 47-inch flat-panel monitor, mobile stand, Surface tablet and stylus pen.

Q. What kind of operating system does the Surface tablet use? **A.** The operating system is Windows 10.

Q. What presentation software is installed on the Surface tablet? **A.** PowerPoint and Adobe Reader are installed.

Q. Are the monitors touchscreen?

A. Yes, the surface tablet allows for touch screen functionality. There will be a stylus pen available as well to control the presentations.

Q. Is there on-site technical assistance?

A. Yes, technical assistance will be provided both before and during the conference. There will always be at least two e-poster technicians on-site to assist presenters with questions.

Q. How much energy do the e-posters use?

A. The e-posters are low energy systems that only use 110 watts of power. Each e-poster (monitor and Surface tablet) can use up to 1 amp of power.
