Who: College/university professors or lecturers interested in attending the Western Users of SAS[®] Software (WUSS) 2020 Conference and meeting each of the following six criteria:

1. Employment with a teaching or research assignment during the 2020–2021 academic year at an accredited degree-granting institution in the WUSS region (i.e., Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming)
2. Plans to use SAS[®] for teaching or research during the 2020–2021 academic year
3. Proof of teaching/research assignment (e.g., via an official letter from institution)
4. New WUSS faculty scholarship awardee (i.e., not previously awarded)
5. Ability to volunteer as a session or class coordinator (i.e., requires a 4-hour commitment)
6. Presentation of a paper (not a Quick Tips or Posters) at WUSS 2020¹

What: Scholarship awardees will receive complimentary conference registration, one complimentary half-day class (Wed AM or Fri PM) and an awardee recognition event
