**Who:** College/university undergraduate or graduate students interested in attending the Western Users of SAS® Software (WUSS) 2020 Conference and meeting each of the following four criteria:

1. Enrollment in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in an accredited degree-granting institution located in the WUSS region (i.e., Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming)
2. Proof of enrollment (e.g., via copies of class schedule or official enrollment confirmation).
3. Ability to volunteer as a session or class coordinator (i.e., requires a 4-hour commitment)
4. Recipient of a WUSS student scholarship no more than once before. Second time scholarship recipients must be accepted to present a paper or poster at WUSS 2020.<sup>1</sup>

**What:** Scholarship awardees will receive complimentary conference registration, one complimentary half-day class (Wed AM or Fri PM) and a recognition event

**When:** September 9–11, 2020

**Where:** Manchester Grand Hyatt, San Diego, California

**How:** Submit a scholarship application by June 1, 2020<sup>2</sup> at <http://wuss.org/student-scholarships/> and a presentation abstract by June 1, 2020 at <http://wuss.org/presenter-resources/> (if applying to receive a second student scholarship).

**Why:** WUSS is the officially recognized regional SAS® users group of the Western United States, providing professional development opportunities and a forum to exchange ideas for educational growth, training, and networking. To further these goals, the WUSS Executive Committee provides a limited number of student scholarships.
